

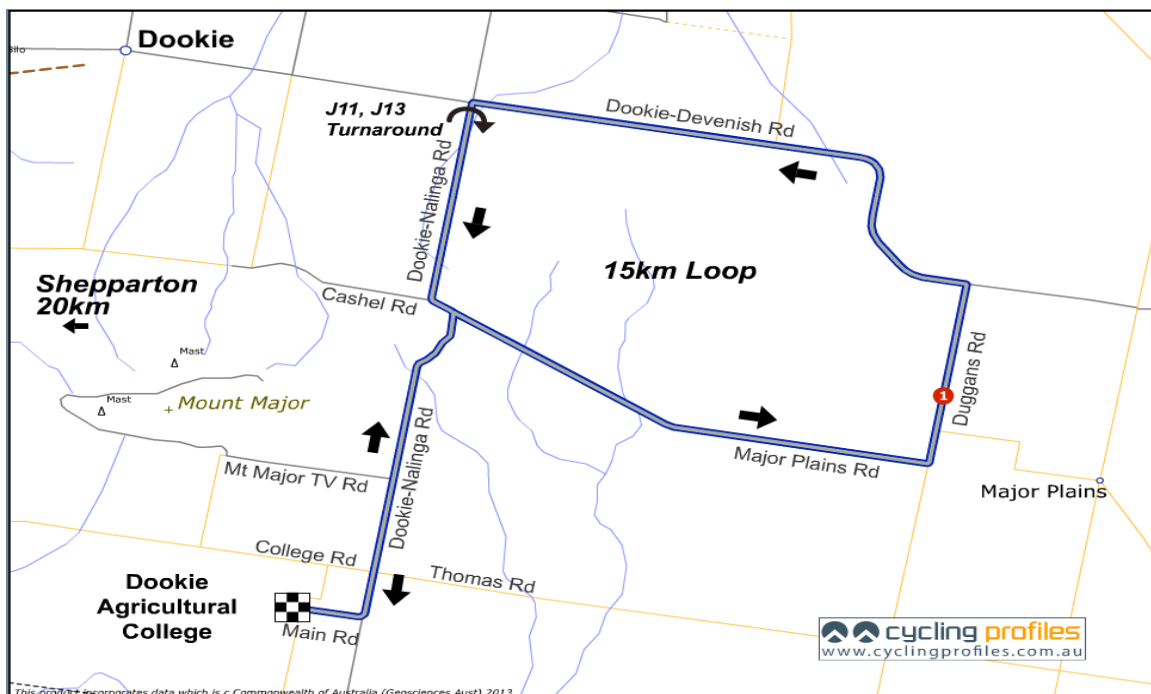
GV Veteran Cycle club are holding their 2017 open on Sunday May 7 at Dookie College from 10 am.

The course will involve 3 laps of a 15 km loop, anti-clockwise, with a 4 km out and back start and finish from the college. (Just ignore the J11, J13 turnaround, as map is from the junior nationals)

The course is easily accessed from both Melbourne and Central Victoria. From Seymour, it is only a little over 1 hour down the Hume Freeway, turning off at Violet Town, or through Shepparton it is only 90 minutes from Bendigo, following the Midland Highway. Dookie in the autumn is a picturesque village, with beautiful volcanic red soil, rolling hills and boutique wineries nearby to enjoy (one of them is on the actual course- Tallis Winery) as well as views of the Strathbogie Ranges.

GV would like to invite all VVCC riders to compete over the two days. On Saturday Hume Vets will host graded scratch races from Benalla and Sunday at Dookie just 20 minutes from both Benalla and Shepparton.
